

## LEAVING A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

By making a bequest to AAPS you can help to build a positive future for the animals that come into our care.

"IMAGINE THE IMPACT YOU CAN CREATE FOR THE ANIMALS"

Your bequest could include a percentage of your estate, a specific monetary amount or assets such as shares or real estate – or you can bequeath the 'residue' of your estate after you have provided for family and friends.

Please consult your solicitor to ensure that your intentions are clear.

The following recommended wording may assist:

'I BEQUEATH to the Australian Animal Protection Society (ABN 51004 948 716), for the general purpose of the Society:

[choose one of the following]

- (a) the sum of \$xxx
- (b) xxx percent of my estate
- (c) the residue of my estate

free of all duties and taxes payable at my death,  
AND I DECLARE that the receipt of the Treasurer for the time being of the Society shall be a sufficient discharge to my Trustee(s).'
