How to leave a gift in your Will

The following recommended wording may assist:

'I BEQUEATH to the Australian Animal Protection Society (ABN 51004 948 716), for the general purpose of the Society: [choose of the following] (a) the sum of \$xxx (b) xxx per cent of my estate (c) the residue of my estate free of all duties and taxes payable at my death, AND I DECLARE that the receipt of the Treasurer for the time being of the Society shall be sufficient discharge to my Trustee(s).'
